

Facilities

Dormitories and Canteen

LUCIAN BLAGA University of Sibiu has about 1900 places available in its 8 hostels, situated in various neighborhoods of the town, equipped as required by the needs of the students (reading rooms, fitness rooms, washing machines, TV sets, kitchenettes, etc.). Dormitories can have up to 4 beds, in most locations, up to 1 bed in hotel-hostels, with restrooms between rooms or even separate for each room. Places in ULBS student hostels are available not only to already enrolled students, but to freshmen of all the faculties in the university too.

The Faculty of Law trains specialists pursuing a legal profession such as: lawyers, legal advisors, magistrates, testifying by the large number of graduates who have embarked on such a career and are currently active at all legal and administrative levels, both national and international.

The Faculty of Law provides 4-year study programs in the field of law (both full time and distance education) in view of obtaining a bachelor degree, as well as a 3-year study program in the field of administrative sciences, with two specializations: public administration and community policing. In keeping with the undergoing educational reforms, the Faculty of Law also includes a Teacher Training Department.

Furthermore, our Faculty also provides several study programs: private judiciary law, Romanian private law institutions, European law and Criminal sciences, in view of obtaining a Master Degree.

Research

Research activity at the Faculty of Law in Sibiu is performed under the aegis of a Research Centre enabling students to actively contribute to the development of Romanian private law and public international law, by means of organizing debates, participating at scientific events, or writing



The Faculty of Law has published its own official journal, Acta Universitatis Lucian Blaga, Jurisprudentia Series, since 2001. This scientific journal emerged as a response to the need of promoting the pertinent and qualified opinions of national and international law specialists.

The Journal Acta Universitatis Lucian Blaga, Jurisprudentia Series is listed on HeinOnline a prestigious American database.

Another journal published twice a year under the aegis of the Faculty of Law is the Romanian Journal of Comparative Law, including studies on comparative law.

Funding



The Faculty of Law provides each year a number of state-funded and tuition fee student places.

The ULBS student performance is encouraged by various incentives such as excellence, performance and study grants. Further more, the university also supports students with specific material or medical conditions, by means of social assistance grants. Their minimum amount covers all accommodation expenses in the student dormitories of LBUS, whereas the amount of performance grants is similar to the minimum wage.

Study opportunities at universities abroad



Students at the Faculty of Law may benefit from opportunities to study abroad facilitated by Erasmus, Scocrates, Leonardo da Vinci programs. Our institution has concluded a number of partnerships with universities from: Marburg, Madrid, Maastricht, Malaga, Dijon, Rennes, Tubingen, Pavia, Riga, Szeged and many others. The study language is either English or/and the language of the home country for the partner institution.

The Faculty of Law also hosts the Latin-American Cultural Centre, set up in October 2011. Its aim is to strengthen the cooperation between Romania and Latin American countries, particularly in the field of law and diplomacy.

The Association of Law Faculties in Latin origin countries was established on 20 May 2011, at the initiative of the Faculty of Law at LBUS and the Faculty of Law of the University of Valladolid. The founding members of the association are the Faculties of Law affiliated to the Universities in Valladolid (Spain), Rennes I (France), Bourgogne – Dijon (France), Coimbra (Portugal), Trento (Italy) and Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu.
