Dormitories and Canteen

LUCIAN BLAGA University of Sibiu has about 1900 places available in its 8 hostels, situated in various neighborhoods of the town, equipped as required by the needs of the students (reading rooms, fitness rooms, washing machines, TV sets, kitchenettes, etc.).

Dormitories can have up to 4 beds, in most locations, up to 1 bed in hotel-hostels, with restrooms between rooms or even separate for each room.

Places in LBUS student hostels are available not only to already enrolled students, but to freshmen of all the faculties in the university too.

Your career

The specializations in the food industries supply theoretical and practical training that will allow graduates to become: technological engineers in production and research facilities in the field of food industry, or in laboratories for quality-assurance and the expert management of food products; technological engineers implementing new technologies and food additives; or engineers for the exploitation, design, or quality management in bioproduction. Apart from companies of the food-processing industry, the graduates can be employed by: the National Authority for Consumers’s Protection (ANPC); institutions of education/training for the food industry; physical-chemical analysis laboratories; veterinary sanitary authorities (DSV); country inspectorates for sanitary control (IJPS); offices for consumer’s protection (OPC) etc. The graduates of Engineering and Management line enjoy the advantages of the double specialization, as both management and technology subjects from the curricula.

This field of expertise is based on an inter-disciplinary approach for engineers-economists endowed with a complex training in food engineering, agritourism and general business. The graduates of agricultural education are trained for work in: plant as well as animal farms; consultancy bodies for agritouristic activities; companies in agriculture and animal breeding activities and businesses for water, air, and soil protection; for environment monitoring and the assessment of ecological impact, for environment audit and dealing with economic data in promoting environment-engineering projects. Along with the above-mentioned fields, graduates can work as experts in country agriculture authorities, municipalities environmental-protection agencies.



Financial support

LBUS students' performance is encouraged and supported, including financially, via scholarships for excellence, performance, and learning.

Those affected by a particularly difficult health or financial condition are supported via social scholarships that amount to the full cost of LBUS dormitory accommodation. Performance scholarships are in the range of the minimum wages in Romania.

Research

Our faculty's experimental farm serves the purpose of practical activities for students' diploma papers and practical training, as specified in the curricula. The farm covers an area of 40 hectares and is located in Rusciori, 6 km from Sibiu.

Student organizations

The Students' League, FASFPIEP, was founded in 2009; it aims to support students' interests, initiatives, and cultural or social activities.

Apart from their own league, our students are also members of AIESEC, the largest international student organization whose main objective is to assist its members in their personal and professional development by means of international experience and leadership opportunities.

Confucius Institute

The Institute organizes classes of Chinese language and civilization, practical courses in Taijiquan, Go, traditional calligraphy etc, and makes Chinese-language reference available.

International relations

LBUS has developed intensive programs of international cooperation, so that its students will benefit from as many career-development opportunities as possible. Student-mobility programs are coordinated by the Department of International Relations together with representatives from all faculties; many students have enjoyed participation in training programs abroad.

There is a considerable variety of availability in opportunities, as LBUS is a party in over 200 agreements with important universities all over Europe.

LBUS is also the only Romanian university that is a participant in the program Erasmus Mundus Mobility with Asia/Erasmus Mundus Mobility with Asia West.
